At the October 15, 2025, Board of Education Regular Meeting the following took place:

- 1. The Board of Education Regular Meeting was called to order by President Schaley at 6:00 pm. Board members present were: Mindy Clark, Brendan Schaley, Dillan Vancil, Lauren Chockley, Karl Gullberg and Mike Lenahan. Absent was Board member Josh Higgins. Also present for the meeting were: Superintendent Stacey Day, District Administrators: Kathy Lafary, Jason Kirby, Stacey Kreps, Brittney Kugler, Byron Helt, Jeremy Hennings and Mallory Nelson and Board Recording Secretary Jaime Shultz. Also in attendance were Will, Carrie and Aiden Todd, Chris, Rachel and Katelyn Ford, Bryan, Floralia and Alesandro McVay and Jimena Perez, Emily, Justine and Mason Schaley, and Kevin Heid.
- 2. President Schaley led the attendees in the Pledge of Allegiance.

- 8. The District received two FOIA requests over the last month. One from Allium Data requesting a summary of the District insurance policies, including deductibles, aggregate coverage, etc. The Galesburg Reporter submitted a request for the names of the most recent inductees to our National Honor Society and any students who received National Merit Scholarship recognition. All requests were submitted within the needed timelines.
- 9. The Board discussed the upcoming Triple I Conference that will take place in November. Board members Schaley, Clark and Lenahan will be attending, as well as Superintendent Day and Recording Secretary Jaime Shultz. The attending members were reminded of travel plans and will report back to the full Board at the December meeting, after the conference.
- 10. The Board discussed the upcoming Elementary Playground project. The playground committee is working on final plans and were able to share posters at the PTC Fall Festival that showed students and families the equipment we hope to purchase. There was lots of excitement from the kids when they saw the pictures! The playground committee set their next meeting for Tuesday, October 28 at 1:00 pm and will focus on fundraising ideas and plans.
- 11. The Building and Grounds committee updated the Board on their current work. The committee is holding a Local Contractor Informational meeting on Wednesday, October 22 at 6:00 pm to explain the process of school construction, bidding, bonding, insurance and our upcoming types of projects. All local contractors are invited to attend. The flyer was sent out to area contractors and is available on our social media and website. Superintendent Day also informed the Board that Summer 2026 projects have been submitted to the architect to start the process and there will be a building and grounds committee meeting after those projects are ready to discuss before posting them for bids.
- 12. The building administrators, district technology director and district special education director gave updates from their monthly reports to the Board.
- 13. Kevin Heid, from Stifel, was in attendance to present information on the HLS Bond for the Board. The Bond was placed for sale on the morning of October 15 and was purchased by local banks, Midwest Bank and Security Savings. The final amount was \$7,670,000 and will be paid off over the next 10 years. The bond will be used to pay for projects in the Districts 10-Year Health-Life-Safety Report. The sale of the bond was approved by a 6-0 roll call vote.
